

Sustainability of the School's Sport Strategy

Middleham's CE School leaders and governors have implemented a strategy for school sport that is both aspirational and sustainable in the long term. We ensure that our use of the premium is sustainable through:

- Teachers working alongside our Sports teacher to enable all staff to learn the skills of teaching PE alongside a specialist when appropriate. This enriches the PE lessons with the Sports teacher and enables class teachers to confidently lead learning in a wide range of PE lessons independently of the Sports teacher.
- Deployment of existing support staff to enable the school's sport provision. This safeguarded position within the school ensures that emphasis is placed on all pupils within our small school having the opportunity to access Level 2 and 3 competition within the area.
- Establishment of charging structure for parents to contribute to the costs of these events. This enables more pupils to access tournaments and sports based activity across the area, reducing our rural isolation and increasing pupils' experience of a wide range of sporting and active pursuits.
- Access for the children to a wider variety of sports including street dance, yoga, boxing and skipping.
- Establishment of a School Council who, with other roles are tasked with the democratic development of school sport for all. Action plans are completed and pupils are coached to effectively lead and develop provision in school.
